Following some collaborative exchange of ideas, inspired on our **tiles** and on the **Dürer's rhinoceros**, we added motion, reproduction and mathematical idealization. The designer **Ana Pedro** produced our logo.

Dürer's rhinoceros is a woodcut executed by the German painter and printmaker Albrecht Dürer about 500 years ago.

Obviously, Dürer never saw the rhinoceros and the woodcut was the artist idealization based on a written description and brief sketch by an unknown artist of an Indian rhinoceros. That rhinoceros arrived in Lisbon in 1515 and was a diplomatic gift to the Portuguese King Manuel I by the Sultan Muzafar II, ruler of Cambay (modern Gujarat). In late 1515, Manuel I sent the animal as a gift for Pope Leo X, but it died in a shipwreck off the coast of Italy in early 1516.
